

Significant Upgrades to CERC DataFinder®

On March 1, DataFinder will unveil two major changes:

- All of the standard data from Applied Geographic Systems will be updated so that the current year estimates will be for 2006 and the estimates will reach to 2011. The data from the 1990 and 2000 Censuses will remain so that comparisons can be made.
- The product will have an upgraded architecture that will change the “look and feel” of the user interface and improve the ease of obtaining data.

These changes will enhance DataFinder and allow users to gather demographic and economic information for geographies not updated annually by federal sources.
